

John P. Wayne Scholarship

General Information

SCHOLARSHIPS

The scholarship will be good for four years but must be reclaimed each year by June 15th and provide grades and updates on activities during the school year.

ELIGIBILITY PROVISIONS

- 1. Must be a senior from High schools in McDonough and Fulton Counties.
- 2. Must enroll in any college or university leading to Bachelor Degrees, their equivalent, or more advanced degrees.
- 3. Must submit an application on the form provided by the Scholarship Committee and include all attachments listed on that form.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

- 1. Each high school may establish a SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE which may be selected in any manner determined by the administrative personnel of the school as well as the school board of the district.
 - a. Each high school with a graduating class of one hundred students or less may submit the name of one candidate
 - b. Each high school with a graduation class in excess of one hundred students, but not exceeding two hundred students, may submit the names of two candidates.
 - c. Each high school with a graduating class of in excess of two hundred students but less than three hundred students may submit the names of three candidates.
- 2. The scholarship committee will then submit their nominations to the TRUSTEE who is the Regional Superintendent of Fulton County and McDonough County Education Region.
- 3. The trustee shall evaluate the qualifications, financial needs, character and potential of each nominee and select and determine the graduating senior or seniors who shall receive financial assistance and benefits from this trust.

Recipient(s) and their high schools will be notified by the committee's decision in May of each school year.
