- What is the refund policy if I am unhappy?
- Does the material have an online component that will require a computer with an internet connection?
- Will I need to purchase a Teacher's Copy of with instructions and answer keys?
- Does the program come with homework and tests?
- Are the materials aligned with Common Core or do they use a different set of learning standards?
- Does the material reflect my educational or religious beliefs?
